Orchids to pre-dominate in all designs but any type of container, plant material or suitable accessories/embellishments may be used for purpose of completing/assisting artistic design. Minimal painted material may be used with discretion. .Beauty being the keynote. Dimensions for Petite Design as per AFAA Manual – page 54 are over 10cm and less than 23cm overall, i.e. height, width and depth.
